Language:

To develop our communication skills we will:

- describe and explain different locations in our world
- explore and describe a variety of different fabric and their properties
- describe different features of exploration and world travel

The arts:

In developing the arts we will:

- explore a range of textiles from around the world
- understand the use of different embellishments and how they can be attached
- design and sew our own blankets based on our investigation
- deepen our understanding of different fabrics and why they are used

Inclusion:

To be as inclusive as possible we will:

- explore the meaning behind the Christmas story and its importance to people around the world.
- create a blanket as a class and develop our teamwork skills

Main Areas of Learning	
As mathematics we will...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> deepen our understanding of numbers to 10 and 20. We will learn strategies to support us with our addition and subtraction for numbers to 10 and 20. We will understand how to create fact families. When learning numbers to 20 we will see patterns within 20 and show multiple representations including use of a number line. We will also learn different positions in queues and understand the language 1st, 2nd, 3rd and before and after.
As writers we will...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> write for a range of purposes including to entertain, to explain and to inform. We will write an 'I Spy' book using different nursery rhymes and story characters such as 'Incy Wincy Spider' and 'Old Mother Hubbard'. We will describe these characters using adjectives and positional language before writing a letter to the characters giving them advice on how to overcome the challenges they face in their story.
As engineers we will...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> explore different ways to shape and create textiles before joining them together using a running stitch to create a blanket. We will decorate these textiles using a number of techniques such as adding sequins.
As technicians we will...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> learn how to move the mouse by moving the cursor over the screen. We will learn how to double-click on an applications icon to open Word, where the spacebar is and how to use it to put spaces between words, know where the backspace key is and how to use it to delete a letter. We will learn how to open Word and Paint. We will learn how to select different brushes and pen tools on Paint.net and know how to select the text tool in Paint.net and click onto the page to then be able to type out a simple sentence
In learning about beliefs we will...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> explore different personal and spiritual journeys. We will be looking at communicating our feelings around journeys by performing role plays. Together we will link our understanding of journeys to reflect the Christmas story.
As geographers we will...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> learn that the North and South Poles are cold areas of the world. We will know that the North Pole is north of the equator and that the South Pole is south of the equator
In learning about ourselves and others we will...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> learn how to prevent accidents. We will understand why we need to tidy up to prevent an accident, how surfaces can become slippery and what we need to do. We will also begin to understand how to call 111 and 999 if someone is hurt or in danger
As athletes we will...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> learn and develop the fundamental movement skills to throw and catch a ball to help us learn how to play cricket. We will also explore how to as a team and work together to perform at the best of our abilities
